Hawk's Landing Community Association (HLCA)

HLCA is a social community association made up of residents who are invested in Hawk's Landing and committed to maintaining a neighbourhood known for beauty, harmony, and good neighbour relationships.

The association helps maintain the entrance gardens and manages the content posted on the community poster-board kiosk near the mailboxes.

Restrictive Covenants

There are restrictive covenants registered on properties in Hawk's Landing. Many relate to building requirements and neighbourhood standards. Their purpose is to help preserve the appearance of the community and support respectful relationships between neighbours.

Please note that the animal restrictions previously listed on page 5, section 15(ii) and 15(iii), are no longer applicable.

Irrigation and Non-Potable Water

Outdoor irrigation water in Hawk's Landing is non-potable. It comes from a small pond located in the Timbers, which is fed by rainwater and a small unnamed creek. A pump house distributes this water to homes in the community.

When Hawk's Landing was first developed, the amount of irrigation water required by the community was underestimated. As a result, Foothills County has placed restrictions on irrigation water consumption.

Irrigation water is typically turned on early in the spring. Residents will receive notice of the start date and a watering schedule. The schedule must be followed, and fines may be issued for non-compliance. If your home has an automated irrigation system, please ensure it is set to your permitted days and times.

Dark Sky Country

Hawk's Landing is located in Dark Sky Country. Local bylaws are intended to reduce light pollution, protect night-sky visibility, and support the work of the Rothney Astrophysical Observatory.

Residents are asked to avoid upward-facing lights, shield outdoor lighting, use motion sensors where practical, and turn off unnecessary exterior lights at night. These steps help preserve the night sky and reduce impacts on neighbours.

Hawk's Landing water, sewer, road maintenance, ditch maintenance, and emergency services are provided by Foothills County. Utility bills are issued every second month by the County.

Garbage collection is on Friday. Please do not put garbage out before Friday morning. Wildlife, including bears, cougars, and birds, may access and scatter garbage left outside overnight.

TC Energy Pipeline and Compressor Station

A TC Energy pipeline runs through the neighbourhood, and a compressor station is located near the Nest on Priddis Greens Drive. These are operated and maintained by TC Energy.

Vehicles are not permitted on or within pipeline corridors. Signs are posted to identify the pipeline area. If you see a vehicle in a pipeline corridor, please report it to Foothills County at 403-652-2341. Non-urgent complaints may also be directed to 403-603-6300.

For questions about the pipeline or compressor station, contact TC Energy at 1-800-661-3805. In an emergency, call 911 first, then contact TC Energy's emergency line at 1-888-982-7222.

Mail and Postal Services

Mail kiosks are located at the junction of Hawk's Landing Drive and Hawk's Landing Rise in the Timbers, and near the entrance to the Nest.

The Bragg Creek Post Office serves Hawk's Landing. Package boxes are available at the mail kiosks, but some registered mail and larger packages must be picked up in Bragg Creek.

Priddis Greens Golf and Country Club

Priddis Greens is a members-only club with two 18-hole golf courses: the Hawk and the Raven.

The Grandview restaurant, wellness program, and winter skiing and snowshoeing on marked trails are open to Hawk's Landing residents. Some restrictions apply to trail use, and residents must sign up before using them.
